

Connections to the Department of Education and Training's electronic alarm service

New buildings delivered through the P21 program are secured in the same way as the existing school site.

This means that a new building will only be connected to an electronic alarm system if one already exists at the school.

Schools that do not already have an alarm system can ask the Department of Education and Training's School Security Unit to update their school's security assessment, taking into account the new P21 works which are being delivered.

If the updated security assessment finds the school to be high-risk an electronic security system can be installed under P21, subject to budget availability.
