Dear school Principal

Following the announcement by the NSW Premier, Mr Barry O'Farrell, the roll out of Interactive Whiteboards has commenced. This roll out will apply to all NSW Public Schools, which received new or refurbished classrooms under the Primary Schools for the 21st Century Program (P21) Building the Education Revolution Program (BER).

This will apply for those BER classrooms where there is not an existing IWB or Interactive Classroom. No IWBs will be installed in classrooms other than those built or refurbished through P21 BER. Some schools may have already installed IWBs as part of their P21 project but there will be no additional IWBs for these rooms.

Should you have excess accommodation, IWBs will not be installed in all rooms, but only those rooms (numbers) equivalent to the number of your permanent classes.

The roll out of IWBs will be in three phases with the exact time of the roll out to depend upon the supply of IWBs. It is anticipated all installations will be complete by start of Term 1 in 2012, if not earlier.

Your school will receive its IWBs in the third phase of the roll out from December – January 2012.
